

North Bay Employment Statistics

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Support text for BOMARC: The Shadow of the Shield at W.K.P. Gallery, North Bay, December, 2007

This table is an amalgamation of data from four existing reports but does not represent statistical 'truth' since no singular document provided the comprehensive and nuanced data that I was looking for. The core of my table is from Statistics Canada's 2001 'Employment by Place-of-Work' for North Bay. The 2006 demographic and employment report by C. N. Watson and Associates ranked the top 25 employers in North Bay and provided the update information to mix with the 2001 data. Although the City of North Bay produced a top 50 list in November 2007, the C. N. Watson report is the only table that included the employment statistics of CFB North Bay. A detailed 2006 statistical report by the Government of Ontario added the fourth point of view but its scope covered the entire Northeastern Ontario region of which the City of North Bay was but one part. It's data, however, provided a crosscheck to North Bay's statistics against those of the larger region.
